BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BAXTER, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$6,144.23 OF REVENUE FUNDS AND RE-APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,409.00 WITHIN THE JUVENILE SERVICES DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, these monies will be appropriated and re-appropriated in the total amount of \$18,553.23 as shown below to purchase a vehicle that replaces a vehicle that has been found to be totaled by the County Insurance Adjustor on 12/3/19 due to an accident.

WHEREAS, the revenue funds in the amount of \$4,799.23 are from insurance (1000-8718) and sale of the vehicle (1000-8711) and \$1,345.00 are from Detention (1000-8724) and Host Home (1000-8723) totaling \$6,144.23.
